Jesus, the good shepherd, dies voluntarily for us so that we can live abundantly through him.

1. Jesus Pictures His Personal Leadership as Our Good Shepherd, 10:1-6

a. The right to lead us, 10:1-5 the presence of the real shepherd whom we can fully trust is confirmed by: the responsiveness of the watchman (connecting the shepherd with his sheep)

the attentiveness of the sheep (voice recognition)

b. The failure to understand Jesus, 10:6 if we're not careful, we can also easily miss the truth that Jesus intends for us

2. Jesus Emphasizes His Personal Sacrifice as Our Good Shepherd, 10:7-21

a. The gracious gate, 10:7-10 Jesus is the entry point into God's kingdom and a life that is full and overflowing

b. The good shepherd, 10:11-18 what distinguishes Jesus as our good shepherd is that he lays down his life for the sheep

c. The mixed response, 10:19-21
