We enjoy the Father's infinite love for us because of the Son's perfect love for him.

1. Jesus is Put to Death on the Cross, 19:16b-37

a. The details of Jesus' physical death, 19:16b-22
the sign: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS

the languages: Aramaic, Latin, and Greek

b. The words at Jesus' physical death, 19:23-30

I am thirsty = Jesus, the God-Man, endures such agonizing thirst so that we might be fully and forever satisfied with his living water (chapter 4)

It is finished = Jesus has completed his God-given mission; the will of the Father has been done on earth, just as it is in heaven

c. The confirmation of Jesus' physical death, 19:31-37

even how the soldiers treat Jesus' body correlates with the Old Testament, signaling once again that God sovereignly fulfills his purposes

2. Jesus is Laid to Rest in the Tomb, 19:38-42

a. The growing courage of Jesus' disciples, 19:38-39

like Joseph and Nicodemus, it's not unusual to treat our faith in Jesus as more of a private thing - but God will open that door for us to step out in boldness to publicly express our love for Jesus

b. The loving honor from Jesus' disciples, 19:40-42
