

God reveals his Glory to all nations in order to receive glory from all Creation.

A.God's Glory: To and through whom is He Glorified?

Psalm 96

- Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth.
- 2 Sing to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day. 3 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples.
- **4** For great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; he is to be feared above all gods. **5** For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the Lord made the heavens.
- 6 Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and glory are in his sanctuary. 7 Ascribe to the Lord, all you families of nations, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.

- 8 Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts.
- **9** Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness; tremble before him, all the earth.
- 10 Say among the nations, "The Lord reigns." The world is firmly established, it cannot be moved; he will judge the peoples with equity.
- 11 Let the heavens rejoice, let the earth be glad; let the sea resound, and all that is in it.
- 12 Let the fields be jubilant, and everything in them; let all the trees of the forest_sing for joy.
- 13 Let all creation rejoice before the Lord, for he comes, he comes to judge the earth.

B. "The Name": God's renown

- 1. Nametag Name--What do you call him?
 - E.g.: Jehovah-Jireh, Lord, God etc.
- 2. Window Name--Revelation
 - E.g.: "The Lord is my shepherd..."
- 3. Fame Name--Reputation
 - E.g.: "His name is exalted..."

The Lord's Prayer

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, 10 your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. 11 Give us today our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation,[a] but deliver us from the evil one. C. Worship: God's purpose and love realized. Rev. 4:8-10

- Holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty,' who was, and is, and is to come."
- **9** Whenever the living creatures give glory, honor and thanks to him who sits on the throne and who lives for ever and ever, **10** the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say:

Rev. 4:9-13

9 "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being." "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased for God persons from every tribe and language and people and nation. 10 You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."

Revelation 5:11-13

11 Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders. 12 In a loud voice they were saying:

- "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"
- 13 Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" 13

A.Abraham: Blessed to bless: This is My name forever Genesis 12: 1-3 The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.

- 2 "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.
- 3 <u>I will</u> bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you <u>I</u> will curse; and <u>all peoples on earth will be blessed through</u> you."

Worship: Motivation greater than obligation

"Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth.

20 And praise be to God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand." Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything 21 The king of Sodom said to Abram, "Give me the people and keep the goods for yourself."

22 But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "With raised hand I have sworn an oath to the Lord, God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth, 23 that I will accept nothing belonging to you, not even a thread or the strap of a sandal, so that you will never be able to say, 'I made Abram rich.' 24 I will accept nothing but what my men have eaten and the share that belongs to the men who went with me. Genesis 14:19-20, 22-


B. Blessing and Glory through and to other nations

Psalm 67: 3-7

- May the peoples praise you, God; may all the peoples praise you.
- 4 May the <u>nations be glad</u> and sing for joy, for you rule the peoples with equity and guide the <u>nations of the earth</u>.
- 5 May the peoples praise you, God; may all the peoples praise you.
- The land yields its harvest; God, our God, blesses us.
- 7 May God bless us still, so that all the ends of the earth will fear him.

B.Exodus: The great display "a people for His name..." God Distinguishes his Name and Shames other gods

- 1. At the Exodus God distinguishes His name from all other gods (Exodus 6)
- 2. God shames the gods of Egypt in open judgment (Exodus 9-11)
- Genesis was written in a covenant agreement form between a King and his "vassal': Kings demonstrated their authority by:
 - a) Defeat and shame enemies;
 - b) Save and honor servants







- 3. God is making a name for himself among nations (Exodus 15, 18)


Ex. 18:9-12

9 Jethro was delighted to hear about all the good things the Lord had done for Israel in rescuing them from the hand of the Egyptians. 10 He said, "Praise be to the Lord, who rescued you from the hand of the Egyptians and of Pharaoh, and who rescued the people from the hand of the Egyptians. 11 Now I know that the Lord is greater than all other gods, for he did this to those who had treated Israel arrogantly." 12 Then Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, brought a burnt offering and other sacrifices to God, and Aaron came with all the elders of Israel to eat a meal with Moses' father-in-law in the presence of God.

4. God's purpose for his covenant people revealed Exodus 19:3-6

Moses tell them:

- 1. Remember what i did... If you obey me and keep my covenant...
- 2. You will be my treasured possession &
- 3. You will be a kingdom of priests and a holy nation

C. The Temple: "...a place...for His name to dwell..."

1. God created a place for his name: The Temple

You must not worship the Lord your God in their way. 5 But you are to seek the place the Lord your God will choose from among all your tribes to put his Name there for his dwelling. To that place you must go; 6 there bring your burnt offerings and sacrifices, your tithes and special gifts, what you have vowed to give and your freewill offerings, and the firstborn of your herds and flocks. 7 There, in the presence of the Lord your God, you and your families shall eat and shall rejoice in everything you have put your hand to, because the Lord your God has blessed you. Deut 12:5-7

- **2. David's response to God.** (1 Chronicles 16:23-30) Sing to the Lord, all the earth; proclaim his salvation day after day.
- **24** Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples. **25** For great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; he is to be feared above all gods.
- 26 For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the Lord made the heavens. 27 Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his dwelling place.
- 28 Ascribe to the Lord, all you families of nations, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength. 29 Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering and come before him. - C. The Temple: "...a place...for His name to dwell..."
 3. Solomon's prayer (1 Kings 8:15 -16, 41-43)
- For he said, 16 'Since the day I brought my people Israel out of Egypt, I have not chosen a city in any tribe of Israel to have a temple built so that my Name might be there...
- 41 "As for the foreigner who does not belong to your people Israel but has come from a distant land because of your name— 42 for they will hear of your great name and your mighty hand and your outstretched arm—when they come and pray toward this temple, **43** then hear from heaven, your dwelling place. Do whatever the foreigner asks of you, so that all the peoples of the earth may know your name and fear you, as do your own people Israel, and may know that this house I have built bears your Name

C. The Temple: "...a place...for His name to dwell..."

4.The nations begin to come (1 Kings 10)

First the queen of sheba but then others...

King Solomon was greater in riches and wisdom than all the other kings of the earth. **24** The whole world sought audience with Solomon to hear the wisdom God had put in his heart.

D. Idolatry and Exile: The Great Delay"...My great name...profaned among the nations..."

1. Idolatry: A Great Profaning (1 Kings 11:4,6,9-11)

As Solomon grew old, his wives turned his heart after other gods, and his heart was not fully devoted to the Lord ... So Solomon did evil in the eyes of the Lord; ... The Lord became angry with Solomon because ... Solomon did not keep the Lord's command. 11 So the Lord said to Solomon, "Since this is your attitude and you have not kept my covenant and my decrees, which I commanded you, I will most certainly tear the kingdom away from you and give it to one of your subordinates. 12 Nevertheless, for the sake of David your father, I will not do it during your lifetime. I will tear it out of the hand of your son.

The Exile: Cont.(Exekiel 36:22-24)

The people of Judah have done evil in my eyes, declares the Lord. They have set up their detestable idols in the house that bears my Name and have defiled it... It is not for your sake, people of Israel, that I am going to do these things, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations where you have gone. 23 I will show the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, the name you have profaned among them. Then the nations will know that I am the Lord, declares the Sovereign Lord, when I am proved holy through you before their eyes.

Exile continued:

24 "For I will take you out of the nations; I will gather you from all the countries 25 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. 26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.

1. Prophetic Vision for His Glory (Continued)

My name will be great among the nations, from where the sun rises to where it sets. In every place incense and pure offerings will be brought to me, because my name will be great among the nations. Mal. 1:11

E. Prophets and Return: Surpassing Hope"...My

name will be great among the nations" 2. A King and Priest (Ezekiel 37, Haggai 2, Psalms 22, 110)

Ezekiel 37 I am going to take the stick of Joseph—which is in Ephraim's hand—and of the Israelite tribes associated with him, and join it to Judah's stick. I will make them into a single stick of wood, and they will become one in my hand.' 20 Hold before their eyes the sticks you have written on 21 and say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I will take the Israelites out of the nations where they have gone. I will gather them from all around and bring them back into their own land. 22 I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel. There will be one king over all of them and they will never again be two nations or be divided into two kingdoms.

III. God's purpose for us, to His Glory: "..for this purpose I came..."

- A. To serve Christ, follow Christ
 - 1. To serve me: love me! 23 Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, John 14:23-24
 - 2. Do as I do: Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, ... Matthew 28:19-20



- Who among the gods is like you, Lord? Who is like you— majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?
- 12 "You stretch out your right hand, and the earth swallows your enemies.
- 13 In your unfailing love you will lead the people you have redeemed.
- In your strength you will guide them to your holy dwelling.
- 14 The nations will hear and tremble; anguish will grip the people of Philistia.
- **15** The chiefs of Edom ...terrified, the leaders of Moab By the power of your arm they will be as still as a stone <u>until your people</u> pass by, Lord, until the people you bought pass by.

(Jer. 7:22- 24)

For when I brought your ancestors out of Egypt and spoke to them, I did not just give them commands about burnt offerings and sacrifices, 23 but I gave them this command: Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. Walk in obedience to all I command you, that it may go well with you. 24 But they did not listen or pay attention; instead, they followed the stubborn inclinations of their evil hearts.

E. Prophets and Return: "My name will be great among the nations" (slide 44)

1. Prophetic Vision for His Glory (Psalm 86, Isaiah 56, Malachi 1)

Among the gods there is none like you, Lord;no deeds can compare with yours. **9** All the nations you have made will come and worship before you, Lord; they will bring glory to your name. **10** For you are great and do marvelous deeds;you alone are God. Psalm 86:8-10

E. Prophets and Return: "My name will be great among the nations" (slide 45)

1. Prophetic Vision for His Glory (Psalm 86, Isaiah 56, Malachi 1)

"To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths, who choose what pleases me and hold fast to my covenant—5 to them I will give within my temple and its walls a memorial and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that will endure forever. 6 And foreigners who bind themselves to the Lord to minister to him, to love the name of the Lord, and to be his servants, all who keep the Sabbath...Isa.56:4-6

2. A King and Priest (Ezekiel 37, Haggai 2, Psalms 22, 110) slide 49)

All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations will bow down before him,

28 for dominion belongs to the Lord and he rules over the nations.

29 All the rich of the earth will feast and worship; all who go down to the dust will kneel before him—those who cannot keep themselves alive.30 Posterity will serve him; future generations will be told about the Lord.31 They will proclaim his righteousness, declaring to a people yet unborn: He has done it!
