We will hear well done from our Master if we do well as his servants.

1. The Master Deposits Valuable Resources into the Hands of His Servants, 25:14-18

- a. The unique assignments, 25:14-15 what the wealthy master entrusts to his servants is essentially comparable to a lifetime of earnings so we could look at these talents as illustrating a lifetime of opportunities
- b. The various responses, 25:16-18 the first two servants do extremely well with a 100% return on the initial investment; the second servant doesn't do squat with what the master gives him

2. The Master Examines Every Servant on the Management of His Property, 25:19-30

a. The amazing rewards, 25:19-23 words that create a smile on our face (well done, good and faithful servant)

work that signals a smile on our master's face (increased responsibility by setting us over much)

b. The severe punishments, 25:24-30 removing the talent that was placed in his hands

banishing the servant who was faithless in his stewardship
