The Father blesses us with his promised Spirit through his crucified Son by our faith.

1. The Father Vindicates Us with His Righteousness by Faith like Abraham, 3:1-9

- a. The supreme blessing of faith, 3:1-6
- we are wise to acknowledge the realistic danger of becoming self-reliant in our pursuit of God starting well with the Spirit, we wind up slipping from the centrality of the gospel doing our own thing
- b. The prime example of faith, 3:7-9

even though we are guilty sinners who fall short of his perfect glory, God blesses us with his righteousness (shalom with God and one another) if we have Abraham-like faith

2. The Father Liberates Us with His Spirit through Faith in Christ, 3:10-14

- a. The curse of living under law, 3:10-12
- if we opt for righteousness through the law, then we are obligated to obey every single command to perfection (Leviticus 18:5)
- b. The blessing of living by faith, 3:13-14

through Jesus redeeming us from the curse of the law, God releases us from sin and sends us his promised Spirit
